STUDENTS AND ALUMNI FEED BACK

(Academic year-2017-18)

- Co-ordination with renowned lawyers practicing in civil, criminal and corporate laws is done to arrange guest lectures on topics of practical utility. Also, the proportion of visiting faculties coming from Law profession was increased.
- Regarding syllabus revision, a workshop is in planning and will be implemented before mid-March for syllabus revision wherein various groups of faculties will be working upon and recommending changes in the course curriculum updating it with recent amendments in law.
- For making classroom teaching more interactive, teachers were instructions to take audio-visual lectures on relevant topics and make it more case based study to impart practical knowledge. Also, students were taken to random visits of courts, police station, jails, and reformative homes to indicate practical application of laws both substantive and procedural.
- 4. Visiting teachers were instructed to submit syllabus completion status on fortnight basis to keep a track of syllabus and were also instructed to inform their absence at least a day before so that alternate arrangement of lecture can be done.
- 5. Furniture repairs are always taken care of by the department and are done from time to time.
- Moot Court Society, Event Society, Literary Society 'Vidhaan' etc were given specific tasks and guidelines to organize and execute more events in institute involving greater participation of students.
- Communication skills workshop is being conducted to groom students with weaker communications skills and for imparting presentation skills.
- 8. Library updation is a usual practice in department.
