2. Year of Establishment :22nd January 1991.

The establishment of the Baha'i Chair for studies in Development at Devi Ahilya University was done by signing a Memorandum Of Understanding by the then Vice Chancellor, Prof. M.S. Sodha, University of Indore and Late Mr. R.N. Shah, Secretary, National Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is of India and endorsed as witnesses by late Dr. V. D. Nagar and Dr. B.C. Chaparwal on 09.04.1990.

In pursuance of the agreement, the permission was sought by the university from the higher Education Department of the Government of Madhya Pradesh, for the establishment of the Baha'i Chair on 22nd January 1991.

3. Vision and Mission Statements :

The purpose of the Baha'i Chair for studies in Development embodied in the agreement was as follows:

- a). To promote Research and scholarship in Baha'i Studies.
- b). To design and conduct courses, seminars, and studies in the field of Baha'i studies and related subjects within an interdisciplinary context and publish results and reports of such activities.
- c). To promote inter-university linkage through seminars, exchange lectures etc. with a view to promote interfaith harmony, national/ international integration and world peace.

- b. To inculcate Values and Morals in the work culture of people.
- c. To provide effective inputs for harmony, peace and prosperity amongst diversified people.

The major Decisions of the Task Force are as follows:

1. The Website of the Baha'i Chair to incorporate all the research work carried by the Scholars at the Baha'i Chair in the Website. It was agreed to include all the achievements, the publication of papers or Books.
2. It was decided to make a list of the Human Resources, who could help at the Baha'i Chair for various activities. Some of the names of such resources have already been identified which will be sent to the members of the Task Force to update so that more experts as resources can be identified for different fields.
3. The Committee also planned to organize a National Conference, tentatively in 2014. The Topic for the Conference would be finalized very soon. It was also decided to write to the Department of External Affairs of the National Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is of India to provide us with some topics. The members of the Task force would also be suggesting some of the topics and sharing it online which would then be approved and finalized.
4. Fifthly, on the question of the Short Term Courses, the courses started by the Chair for smaller groups of the Faculty members should carry on. Such smaller groups comprising of the university and college Faculties would be invited for a workshop focusing on Value Education, emphasized more by the N.A.A.C. Dr. (Mrs.) Janak Palta McGilligan volunteered to be one of the Resource person for some of these short term workshops.
5. Two other courses were discussed, one was the Orientation of the newly appointed Lecturers at the colleges and the University with the three Modules

(a.) Teaching learning methodology (b.) knowing the higher education (c) . personality and attitude development, However, the Course on the newly appointed faculties would be taken up later as it would require the approval of the university.

5.1. The other program, on ASHA- Abilities, Skills And Healthy Attitudes, a skill development for the Post Graduate Students could be taken up.

5.2. Orientation program for the National Service Scheme could also be conducted by the Baha'i Chair as both aim for the service and the betterment of the society. So, it was decided to identify the possibility of having such program on Moral Capability for Social Action.

6. The UGC sponsored projects and the funded schemes will be identified and shared to all the members of the Task force.

7. It was also decided to make a list of the University Departments and Institutions in Indore whom we could approach with a brochure of the Chair containing its objectives and what we would like to give to the Institutions.

7. Yearly Plans and Operational Policies: The Baha'i Chair For Studies in Development, plans to organize workshops and symposiums for the Faculty of the University and Colleges as well as the Post Graduate students.

D. Funding

The Funding at the Baha'i Chair was initially started by a corpus fund- Interest income provided by the National Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is of India (Rs. 12 lakh in April 1990 and Rs. 18 lakh in August 2001). The University manages the endowment fund. All interest proceeds of this fund is expended for the purpose of the activities of the Baha'i Chair for studies in Development, and the salary of the staff.

It is mentioned in the Memorandum of Understanding between the University and the National Assembly that further funds, if and when required, for the operation of this chair will be raised by the university and the National Spiritual Assembly.

The Expenses of Baha'i Chair For Studies in Development Devi Ahilya Vishwavidyalaya like salary payment, workshop expenses etc is born by the interest received from the Corpus Fund. This Corpus Fund has been deposited by the National Spiritual Assembly of the Baha'is of India New Delhi, with the University.
