

SPORTS SECTION

All the sporting activities are organized by Sports Committee headed by Vice Chancellor of the University & Director of Physical being secretary. The day to day activities are controlled by Executive Sports Board appointed by the Sports Committee.

There are 8 districts in the jurisdiction of the university and most of them are in tribal belts. The sporting activities are organized as per the calendar of Association of Indian Universities & the calendar of the M.P. Government Department of Higher Education.

The Sports activities are organized in three layers i.e. Intercollegiate, M.P. State Inter University & All India Inter University tournaments.

The important information of university sporting activities for 2011-2012 are given as under :-

(I) Intercollegiate Tournaments :-

These tournaments were organized in 24 disciplines in men section & 18 disciplines in women section.

It is the practice of the university to allot as many as possible tournaments to the colleges located in the tribal belts in order to promote the games & sports in the remote areas.

The merit certificates were given to first three position holder in the individual events & winners & runners in the team events.

(II) Participation in the M.P. State Inter University Tournaments.

M.P. State Inter University Tournament is organized in 12 disciplines men section & 10 disciplines in women section.
