(1) Curricular Aspects 50/150

- (1) (a) Reflection of institutional vision and mission in academic programmes,
- (b) A systematic process (need assessment, feedback, etc.) in the design and development of the curriculum,

(2) Academic Flexibility

- Academic Flexibility by
 - i. adoption of the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS)
 - j. promotion of inter-disciplinary programmes
 - k. programmes in emerging areas

(3) Curriculum Enrichment, review and updating at regular intervals (30/150)

- i. Making it socially relevant and/or job oriented / knowledge intensive and meeting the emerging needs of students and other stakeholders

(3) Curriculum Enrichment, review and updating at regular intervals

- ii. introduction of higher order skill development programmes in consonance with the national requirements as outlined by the National Skills Development Corporation and other agencies

(4) Feedback System (20/150)

- Obtaining feedback from students regarding the curriculum, from national and international faculty, conducting webinars, workshops, online discussions, etc. and its impact on curricular development, a mechanism through which affiliated institutions give feedback on curriculum enrichment
